Reasons for decision:

- 1. The Board is not satisfied that the school will comply with the following accreditation criteria prescribed under the Education (Accreditation of Non-State Schools) Regulation 2001 (the "Regulation") after the change in attribute to include the site at South Street is effected:
  - (a) land and buildings (Regulation, section 12, refers); and
  - (b) educational facilities and materials (Regulation, section 13, refers).
- 2. The Board has made this determination on the following basis:
  - (a) the applicant's proposed commencement date for the new site is 12 July 2010;
  - (b) having regard to the information provided in the application and provided subsequently by the applicant in support of the application, the applicant has not satisfied the Board that:
    - (i) the school will comply with relevant land use legislation and building legislation in relation to the South Street site by the stated commencement date; and
    - (ii) the school will have the education facilities and materials necessary for the effective delivery of the school's educational program at the South Street site by the stated commencement date.

Right of review:

The applicant has a right to apply to the Minister for Education and Training for a review of the Board's decision to refuse grant the application.

The application for review must be made within 28 days after this

Information Notice is given to the applicant.

The application for review must be in writing and state fully the grounds of the application.

Under section 103 of the Act, after reviewing the original decision the Minister may either:

- refer the matter to which the decision relates back to the Board for further consideration, subject to any directions decided by the Minister; or
- (ii) decline to refer the matter to which the decision relates back to the Board for further consideration.

Sections 101, 102 and 103 of the Act give more information about the way in which the Board's decision is reviewed if an application for review is lodged.

I am unsure as to why accreditation is being denied because land use consent has not been received from the Toowoomba Regional Council. (I am assuming that all other accreditation criteria have been ticked-off).

The Board has in the past granted accreditation in cases where land use consent has not been received.

If the Board is now going to require land use consent prior to granting provisional accreditation, then I am concerned that there will be a significant increase in the number of applications being refused on the basis of the nine months provision. I don't believe that this is the intention of the legislation.

It is my view that provisional accreditation should be granted and then it is a matter for the school to resolve the land use consent issue within the required timeframe applying to provisional accreditation. Clearly, if the school does not get the required land use consent, the provisional accreditation would be surrendered.

Mike Byrne: mikeb@qcec.catholic.edu.au Thursday, 29 April 2010 5:05 PM ... if forced to make a decision at this time I would favour conditional approval.

I am on the road during this week and have found it difficult to get my head around the issues again and would have appreciated the opportunity to discuss the issue with the Board. My own position is that it is a matter for the Council to consider zoning approval for the school based on their processes. I don't believe that it is the role of the Board to presume what decision the Council might make and on that basis refuse approval.

I am aware that over recent years the Board has made several decisions to grant approval subject to Council approval at a later date. I think we put ourselves in a difficult position as a Board if we now decide to refuse this application. I recognise that the Board does have a number of concerns about the site e.g. proximity to toilets and supervision. I believe these matters can be resolved by the Board with further negotiation and discussion.

Again, I would dearly like to discuss this with Board members but if forced to make a decision at this time I would fayour conditional approval.



Dear Vi

I am unsure as to why accreditation is being denied because land use consent has not been received from the Toowoomba Regional Council. (I am assuming that all other accreditation criteria have been ticked-off).

The Board has in the past granted accreditation in cases where and use consent has not been received.

If the Board is now going to require land use consent prior to granting provisional accreditation, then I am concerned that there will be a significant increase in the number of applications being refused on the basis of the nine months provision. I don't believe that this is the intention of the legislation.

It is my view that provisional accreditation should be granted and then it is a matter for the school to resolve the land use consent issue within the required timeframe applying to provisional accreditation. Clearly, if the school does not get the required land use consent, the provisional accreditation would be surrendered.

For these reasons, I do not support the motion.

- 1. - 2. Perhaps not necessary now but for next time I would like to see a slightly different wording of the resolution, having regard to the wording of s.52. I would prefer the resolution to say "that the Board is not satisfied that after the change in attribute is effected, the school will comply with ...etc"
