Form: NSS-TS2, *Special assistance school — Notice that use of temporary site is stopped*, collects information by authority of the *Education (Accreditation of Non-State Schools) Act 2001*, section 60D.

Under the *Education (Accreditation of Non-State Schools) Act 2001* and the *Education (Accreditation of Non-State Schools) Regulation 2001*, a special assistance school may provide, on a temporary basis, special assistance at a temporary site.

Information collected in this notice may be disclosed to the following:

- (i) the Minister for Education;
- (ii) officers of the Department of Education and Training; and
- (iii) assessors and auditors appointed under the *Education (Accreditation of Non-State Schools) Act 2001*.

Certain information collected in this notice may also be published under *Open Data (data.qld.gov.au)* if suitable for release.

The following information collected in this notice is 'personal information' within the meaning of the *Information Privacy Act 2009*:

- (i) full name, telephone number(s) and email address of the authorised person; and
- (ii) signature of the authorised person.

The information contained in this notice is subject to the *Right to Information Act 2009*.

Important information

1. This *Special assistance school — Notice that use of temporary site is stopped* (the "notice") is authorised by the *Education (Accreditation of Non-State Schools) Act 2001*, section 60D, and applies if the governing body of a non-State special assistance school stops providing special assistance at a temporary site.
2. The *Education (Accreditation of Non-State Schools) Act 2001* provides for special assistance school temporary sites, principally under: chapter 2, part 3A; and chapter 2, part 2, division 3, subdivision 3.
3. The *Education (Accreditation of Non-State Schools) Regulation 2001* provides for special assistance school temporary sites, principally under part 2AA.
4. Section 60D requires the Non-State Schools Accreditation Board (the "Board") to notify the governing body that it has received the notice.
5. The Board's notification will be posted by ordinary mail to the governing body at the governing body's office address held by the Board.
6. The individual making the declaration on this notice for the governing body will be contacted in the first instance if any information submitted on this notice requires attention or clarification.
