
Is the student eligible for inclusion in the School Survey Data for Non-State Schools – Queensland

a) a dependent of a person who is receiving a sponsorship for the purpose of undertaking a course provided by an institution in Australia that:
i. is a Table A provider or a Table B provider (within the meaning of the Higher Education Support Act 2003); and
ii. is meeting the full cost of the education component of the course;
b) a person who is undertaking a course of study provided by an institution or body in Australia under a Student Exchange Program registered by the relevant education authority in the State or Territory where the person is undertaking the Program; or c) a person, or a dependent of a person, who is receiving a sponsorship or scholarship from the Commonwealth for the purpose of undertaking a course provided by an institution or other body or person in Australia.
4 = Documented evidence confirming the reasons preventing the student from attending the school must be retained by the school for a period of five years from Census day, and in a way that ensures the integrity and security of the data and documents.
